For our Conversation today:

Inclusive Post Secondary Education or "IPSE" relates to students with intellectual/developmental disabilities (IDD) attending college:

INCLUSIVE

Students have full access to the campus. Attending classes, living in dorms, participating fully.

POST-SECONDARY

Students have completed High School.

EDUCATION

Students are learning beyond academics. Education includes many facets.

DATA

- Over 350 college programs listed on the Think College website
- 3 college programs in Oklahoma for students with intellectual/developmental disabilities
- More are needed!

NATIONAL OVERVIEW

OUTCOME DATA

(After High School)

- 36.8% of individuals with a cognitive disability are employed. (1)
- 74% of students with IDD who completed IPSE programs have competitive employment. (2)
- 83% of students reported they were happy or very happy with social life. (2)
